## Directions Regarding Leased Berths and Other Facilities at the Dapeng Bay Marina

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- 1. The Dapeng Bay National Scenic Area Administration, Tourism Bureau, Ministry of Transportation and Communications, has drafted these regulations in order to uniformly standardize the lease management rules governing berth positions at Dapeng Bay Marina.
- 2. The types of berths at the Marina and their use are as follows:
  - i. Long-term rental berths (monthly rental type): For vessels that need to berth for long periods; they have the exclusive right to use the berth during the lease period.
  - ii. Short-term rental berths (daily charter): vessels that are berthed for a short period of time with the approval of the department; berthing time should not exceed 30 days, in principle.
  - iii. Business berths: leased to vessels approved by the shipping administration authority and department to enter the Dapeng Bay area to conduct business.
  - iv. Official vessels: only for berthing of vessels operated by the Administration or other official ships. Marked with yellow lines.
  - v. Other types of ships or floating devices are not allowed to berth without the agreement of the department.
- 3. Other than in an emergency, vessels applying to berth are required to confirm with the Administration by phone (08-8338100) before entering the Dapeng Bay area. After being notified of berth position availability and permission to enter the Dapeng Bay area, it is required to berth at the location instructed by the staff of the Administration and fill out the "Application Form for Berthing" and submit it to the Administration to lease the berth.
- 4. Anyone who applies to berth at a berth position of the Dapeng Bay Marina must follow the "Key Points for Management of the Use of Dapeng Bay Marina Facilities".
- 5. The key point application forms are attached as Addendums 1, 2, and 3; the Administration may amend these as and when necessary.
